MEET BRAD SCHEU:

Dr. Scheu had his first health care experience as a patient care tech in 2006 before starting a clinical career as a Deaconess hospitalist in 2014. Early on, his skill and bedside manner were recognized by hospital leadership. When he began his office practice in 2015, it was nearly full within a few weeks due to the number of physicians and other employees who selected him as their primary care provider.

After several years in the office setting, he was promoted to Medical Director of Primary Care at Deaconess Clinic in 2019, where he oversaw quality initiatives for all Deaconess Clinic primary care physicians, while continuing to practice part-time.

Dr. Scheu became vice president and chief medical officer at Deaconess Clinic, on October 1, 2020. Deaconess Clinic employs more than 300 physicians and advance practice providers in 50 locations throughout the region.

In the months leading up to his promotion, he guided Deaconess Clinic providers through extensive changes related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Dr. Scheu completed his Doctor of Osteopathy at Kansas City University, residency training in internal medicine at the University of Kansas, and his MBA in healthcare leadership from Rockhurst University in 2011.

He is a volunteer faculty member at the Indiana University School of Medicine-Evansville, member of the University of Evansville Physician Assistant Advisory Board, and is a fellow of the American College of Physicians.
